MOROCCO - ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW SCHEDULE LXXXI

Extension of Time-Limit

The following communication, dated 6 December 1993, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Morocco.

With reference to the Council's Decision dated 19 July 1993¹ suspending for the Kingdom of Morocco the application of the provisions of Article II of the General Agreement until 31 December 1993 in order to enable the transposition of Morocco's CCCN schedule of accession to the Harmonized System, I have the honour to inform you that owing to the latest adjustments to the customs tariff reform agreed with the IBRD as part of the structural adjustment programme and consisting of the elimination of the last quantitative restrictions, our country has been unable to submit the documentation required under the procedure established by the Council of 12 June 1983 (BISD 30S/17).

It therefore requests a temporary exemption from its obligations under Article II of the General Agreement until 30 June 1994, and naturally undertakes to submit the required documentation as rapidly as possible.

It should be noted that the transposition will not modify in any way Morocco's undertakings with regard to other contracting parties.
