ADMISSION OF GRENADA AS A CONTRACTING PARTY

Certification by the Director-General

In document L/4014 of 4 April 1974, contracting parties were informed by the Government of the United Kingdom, that on 7 February 1974 Grenada acquired full autonomy in the conduct of its external commercial relations and other matters provided for in the General Agreement. Thus the fact that Grenada was qualified in the sense of paragraph 5(c) of Article XXVI to become a contracting party has been established.

The Government of Grenada has been applying the General Agreement on a <u>de facto</u> basis, pursuant to the recommendations of the CONTRACTING PARTIES of 18 November 1960 and of 11 November 1967. On 9 February 1994, the Government of Grenada communicated to me its decision to become a contracting party to the General Agreement under the provisions of Article XXVI:5(c). Since the conditions required by this Article have been met, Grenada has become a contracting party on 9 February 1994, its rights and obligations date from 7 February 1974.
