ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification transmitted under Articles 7 and 8

Extension and modification of the agreement between  
Canada and Singapore

The Textiles Surveillance Body received a notification under Article 4 from Canada of an extension and modification of its agreement with Singapore for the period 1 January to 31 December 1993.<sup>1</sup>

The TSB decided to transmit the text of the notification to participating countries under Articles 7 and 8 as Singapore had not as yet accepted the 1993 Protocol maintaining in force the Arrangement.<sup>2</sup>

**Canada-Singapore Textile and Clothing Consultations**

**Agreed Record of Discussions**

1. Delegations representing the Government of Canada and the Government of the Republic of Singapore met on 14-16 September 1992, in Ottawa, to discuss the extension to 31 December 1993, of the Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Republic of Singapore relating to the export from Singapore of certain textiles and textile products.
2. The two delegations agreed to extend the MOU for one year to 31 December 1993.
3. This extension is without prejudice to the results of the Uruguay Round of Multilateral Trade Negotiations.
4. This Agreed Record will become effective on 1 January 1993, subsequent to an exchange of letters between the two governments confirming their acceptance of this arrangement.

**Canada-Singapore Textile and Clothing HS Conversion Consultations**

**Agreed Record of Discussions**

1. Delegations representing the Government of Canada and the Government of the Republic of Singapore met on 14-16 September 1992, in Ottawa, to discuss the conversion of the Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") between the Government of Canada and the Government of Singapore relating to the export from Singapore of certain textiles and textile products, to an arrangement based on the Harmonized System ("HS").
2. The two delegations had detailed discussions on the HS conversion and exchanged views on the matter of extending the MOU. They agreed that, for the purposes of extending the MOU, beyond 31 December 1992, Annexes I and II of this Agreed Record will serve as the basis for any such extension.
3. They agreed that this Agreed Record is without prejudice to any agreement on the extension of the MOU.

**ANNEX II - PREAMBLE**

**SINGAPORE**

1. Unless otherwise indicated, gender means garments for men (M), boys (B) (sizes 8 to 18), women (W), girls (G) (sizes 7 to 16), children (C) (sizes 2 to 6X) and babies, of a body height not exceeding 86 cm (sizes 0 to 24 months).
2. Unless otherwise indicated, swing is permitted from adult garments to children's and babies' garments at a 3 to 5 ratio.
3. A partially manufactured textile article shall be taken to include an article unfinished or incomplete (including cut or shaped fabric for making such articles), provided that, as presented, the incomplete or unfinished article has the essential character of the complete or finished article. It shall also be taken to include the article presented unassembled or disassembled.
4. Garments of indeterminate gender, including unisex garments are to be counted as of female gender.
5. Unless otherwise indicated, products covered by restraints under this arrangement in Group I and in Group II are those which predominate by weight of wool, cotton or man-made fibres.
