5.	Title and number of pages of the notified document: Draft Regulation Governing an Inspection System for Refillable Plastic Bottles (2 pages)
6.	Description of content: The aim of the draft Regulation is to ensure that refillable plastic bottles are guided through State-of-the-art inspection equipment ("sniffers") to establish whether the bottles have been polluted with harmful substances before they are refilled with soft drinks and/or waters. The Regulation also stipulates requirements for the inspection equipment.
7.	Objective and rationale: The aim of the Regulation is to prevent refillable plastic bottles from being refilled which may contain undesirable, health and life-threatening substances to man. Companies which refill the bottles in question must guide these through a "sniffer" which meets certain specifications. This equipment rejects polluted bottles from the production process. There are no regulations to this effect at EU level.
