Description of content: The Commission is proposing to incorporate the requirements of the Child Safety Protection Act of 1994 (CSPA) into the Code of Federal Regulations and to interpret or clarify certain provisions of that legislation. The CSPA amended the Federal Hazardous Substances Act by adding a new Section 24, which imposes labelling requirements on balls, balloons, marbles, and certain toys and games intended for use by children three years of age and older. The amendment also bans certain balls intended for use by children younger than three years of age and requires that choking incidents involving small balls, balloons, marbles, and toys or games containing such articles or other small parts must be reported to the Commission.
