Description of content: The Administration proposes to amend the labelling requirements of FMVSS No. 109, New Pneumatic Tires, to permit tires that have a maximum inflation pressure of 60 pounds per square meth (PSI) to be labelled "inflate to 420 KPA (60 PSI)". Currently, the Standard does not permit the metric unit to be on the label. This notice also proposes to correct a typographical error in S4.3 of the Standard.
7.	Objective and rationale: The proposal would aid the International Harmonization of Standards.
