# Extension of the agreement between Canada and China

The Textiles Surveillance Body received a notification from Canada of two extensions of its agreement with China. The first extension covered the period 1 January to 31 December 1993 and the second extension for the twelve-month period ending 31 December 1994.

The TSB, pursuant to its procedures regarding notifications received under Article 4<sup>2</sup>, has examined the relevant documentation and is forwarding the text of the notification to participating countries for their information.

# Canada-China Textile and Clothing HS Conversion Consultations Agreed Record of Discussions

- 1. Delegations representing the Government of Canada and the Government of the People's Republic of China met on 3 to 5 November 1992, in Beijing, to discuss the conversion of the Memorandums of Understanding between the Government of Canada and the Government of the People's Republic of China relating to the export from China of certain textiles and textile products and of cotton fabrics and polyester/cotton fabrics for import into Canada ("the MOUs"), to an arrangement based on the Harmonized System ("the HS"), as well as to discuss the extension of the MOUs beyond 31 December 1992.
- 2. The two delegations agreed to extend the MOUs for a one-year period from 1 January 1993 to 31 December 1993. The extension of the MOUs is based on Annexes I and II to this agreed record and the other terms and conditions contained in the current MOUs.
- 3. Annexes I and II attached hereto will thus replace Annexes IA, IB and II of the textile and textile product MOU and the product descriptions and restraint levels contained in the cotton fabric and polyester/cotton fabric MOU.

#### **ANNEX II - PREAMBLE**

#### China

- 1. Unless otherwise indicated, gender means garments for men (M), boys (B) (sizes 8 to 18), women (W), girls (G) (sizes 7 to 16), children (C) (sizes 2 to 6X) and babies, of a body height not exceeding 86 cm (sizes 0 to 24 months).
- 2. Unless otherwise indicated, swing is permitted from adult garmerats to children's and babies' garmerats at a 3 to 5 ratio.
- 3. A partially manufactured textile article shall be taken to include an article unfinished or incomplete (including cut or shaped fabric for making such articles), provided that, as presented, the incomplete or unfinished article has the essential character of the complete or finished article. It shall also be taken to include the article presented unassembled or disassembled.
- 4. Garments of indeterminate gender, including unisex garments, are to be counted as of female gender.
- 5. Unless otherwise indicated, products covered by restraints under this arrangement in Group I and in Group II are those which predominate by weight of wool, cotton, or man-made fibres.
- 6. Unless otherwise indicated, any reference to fabrics includes fabrics impregnated, coated, covered or laminated, where the non-textile substance accounts for 50 per cent or less by weight.
