ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification under Articles 7 and 8

**Extension of the Statement of Intent between
Canada and Chinese Taipei**

The Textiles Surveillance Body received a notification from Canada of an extension of the "Statement of Intent Relating to the Export from Taiwan of Certain Textiles and Textile Products for Import into Canada" until 31 December 1995.

This notification has been made pursuant to a request made by the Textiles Committee that agreements concluded with non-participants be notified.

The TSB is forwarding the text of the notification to participating countries for their information.

AGREED RECORD OF DISCUSSION

1. Delegations from the Taiwan Textile Federation and the Government of Canada met in Hong Kong on 22-24 June 1992, to discuss the conversion of Annexes I and II of the Statement of Intent to Annexes based on the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (HS).
2. It was agreed that effective 1 January 1993, Annexes I and II of this Agreed Record will replace Annexes I and II of the Statement of Intent with the exception for polyester filament fabrics and polyester rayon fabrics. With respect to these two products, the two delegations agreed to study each other's proposals and to communicate further on this matter.
3. With respect to Category 14, the Taiwan Textile Federation agreed that exports to Canada of babies' garments in sub-categories 14.1, 14.2, 14.3, 14.4, 14.5, 14.7 and 14.8 individually shall not exceed 10 per cent of the annual restraint level of category 14; that for sub-category 14.6 those exports to Canada shall not exceed 35 per cent of the annual level for category 14; and for sub-category 14.9 those exports shall not exceed 50 per cent of the annual level for category 14.
4. It was agreed that special swing would be allowed in 1993 on an equivalent quantity of the upper and lower garment basis from suit categories to relevant component garment categories as follows:

5. It was agreed to consult promptly on any questions which may arise regarding the implementation of the Harmonized System with respect to the Statement of Intent. It was also agreed that a review of the implementations of the HS Conversion should take place in 1993, including the provisions for special swing and flexibility.

ANNEX II - PREAMBLE**TAIWAN**

1. Unless otherwise indicated, gender means garments for men (M), boys (B) (sizes 8 to 18), women (W), girls (G) (sizes 7 to 16), children (C) (sizes 2 to 6X) and babies, of a body height not exceeding 86 cm (sizes 0 to 24 months).
2. Unless otherwise indicated, swing is permitted from adult garments to children's garments at a 3 to 5 ratio.
3. A partially manufactured textile article shall be taken to include an article unfinished or incomplete (including cut or shaped fabric for making such articles), provided that, as presented, the incomplete or unfinished article has the essential character of the complete or finished article. It shall also be taken to include the article presented unassembled or disassembled.
4. Garments of indeterminate gender, including unisex garments, are to be counted as of female gender.
5. Unless otherwise indicated, products covered by restraints under this arrangement in Group I and in Group II are those which predominate by weight of silk, wool, cotton, other vegetable fibres or man-made fibres.
Excluded are products of Group I containing more than 85 per cent by weight of vegetable fibres, other than cotton, or more than 70 per cent by weight of silk fibres.
6. Unless otherwise indicated, any reference to fabrics includes fabrics impregnated, coated, covered or laminated, where the non-textile substance accounts for 50 per cent or less by weight.

ANNEX II - PREAMBLE

TAIWAN

1. Unless otherwise indicated, gender means garments for men (M), boys (B) (sizes 8 to 18), women (W), girls (G) (sizes 7 to 16), children (C) (sizes 2 to 6X) and babies, of a body height not exceeding 86 cm (sizes 0 to 24 months).
2. Unless otherwise indicated, swing is permitted from adult garments to children's garments at a 3 to 5 ratio.
3. A partially manufactured textile article shall be taken to include an article unfinished or incomplete (including cut or shaped fabric for making such articles), provided that, as presented, the incomplete or unfinished article has the essential character of the complete or finished article. It shall also be taken to include the article presented unassembled or disassembled.
4. Garments of indeterminate gender, including unisex garments, are to be counted as of female gender.
5. Unless otherwise indicated, products covered by restraints under this arrangement in Group I and in Group II are those which predominate by weight of silk, wool, cotton, other vegetable fibres or man-made fibres.
Excluded are products of Group I containing more than 85 per cent by weight of vegetable fibres, other than cotton, or more than 70 per cent by weight of silk fibres.
6. Unless otherwise indicated, any reference to fabrics includes fabrics impregnated, coated, covered or laminated, where the non-textile substance accounts for 50 per cent or less by weight.

I am writing to you concerning the extension beyond 1993 of the Statement of Intent signed by the Taiwan Textile Federation relating to the export from Taiwan of certain textiles and textile products for import into Canada.

As you are aware, there is at present some degree of uncertainty with respect to the rules which will govern our bilateral trade in textiles and clothing in 1994. At the same time, orders have already been placed for delivery in 1994, and manufacturers in Canada and in Taiwan will soon have to produce the items necessary to meet their 1994 delivery commitments. Canadian importers have also committed themselves to meet increasingly stringent deadlines for delivery to their Canadian customers. In the absence of the extension of the Statement of Intent, we are not in a position at this time to counsel Canadian importers on whether the current import régime would continue into 1994.

You will appreciate that we remain fully committed to maintaining an effective import control policy for the textile and clothing industries in order to moderate growth in low-cost imports and to provide the Canadian industry with a climate that is conducive to an orderly adjustment process. At the same time, the current Statement of Intent has served to ensure secure terms of access for textiles and clothing exports from Taiwan.

I would propose, therefore, that the Statement of Intent be extended until 31 December 1994 or, if the Taiwan Textile Federation is agreeable, to 31 December 1995. This extension would apply to all terms and conditions contained in the current Statement of Intent, including growth rates and flexibility provisions.

If the Taiwan Textile Federation is in agreement with the proposed extension of the Statement of Intent, I would propose further that this letter, along with the reply from the Taiwan Textile Federation, constitute an arrangement extending the Statement of Intent until the date on which we mutually agree.

This refers to our meeting of 8 December 1993 concerning an extension of the Statement of Intent relating to the export of certain textiles and textile products from Taiwan to Canada during the period ending 31 December 1993.

The situation regarding international trade in textiles has been reviewed and it is proposed that the terms of the Statement of Intent be extended for a period of two years, until 31 December 1995, in order to provide certainty to those engaged in textile trade between the two countries. It is further proposed that the extension would apply to all terms and conditions in the Statement of Intent including growth rates, flexibility provisions and carryover/carry forward provisions between 1993 and 1994.

It is noted that the extension proposed will have the further effect of amending paragraphs 4 and 6 of the Statement of Intent so as to extend the period of application of all of the provisions of the Statement of Intent for two years i.e. 31 December 1995. It is assumed that the extension will also apply to paragraph 16 regarding carry forward arrangements.

It is also assumed that in the event that Taiwan becomes a member of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (GATT), or any successor organization prior to 31 December 1995, that the Canadian Government would be prepared to give every consideration to extend the benefits of the GATT Uruguay Round Agreement on Textiles and Clothing to export of certain textiles and textile products from Taiwan to Canada.

In the event that Taiwan should not become a member of the GATT during the period of the proposed extension of the Statement of Intent, i.e. 31 December 1995, it is assumed that the Canadian Government, if requested to consult, would be prepared to give consideration to possible adjustment of the Statement of Intent to reflect similar conditions to those provided in the GATT Agreement on Textiles and Clothing, effective 1 July 1995.

It would be appreciated if an early response could be received to this extension proposal as well as your views on how best to give effect to this proposed extension.

This refers to your letter of 21 December 1993 and the letter to you from my colleague Mr. Jean Saint-Jacques, dated 26 July 1993, regarding the Statement of Intent signed by the Taiwan Textile Federation relating to the export from Taiwan of certain textiles and textile products for import into Canada.

I am pleased to note your concurrence with our proposal that the Statement of Intent, including all the terms and conditions therein, be extended for a period of two years, until 31 December 1995.

In your letter you raise two other points regarding arrangements beyond 1 July 1995, when the Uruguay Round Agreement on Textiles and Clothing is scheduled to come into effect.

On the first point, I can confirm that Canada would be prepared to give every consideration to extend the benefits of the Uruguay Round Agreement to the export of certain textiles and textile products from Taiwan to Canada in the event that Taiwan becomes a contracting party to the GATT prior to 1 July 1995.

On the second point, in the event that Taiwan is not a contracting party to the GATT prior to 1 July 1995, Canada would be prepared to consult, if requested, regarding future arrangements for trade in textiles. As I had indicated to you on 8 December, however, benefits accruing from the Uruguay Round Agreement on Textiles flow from a wide-ranging multilateral effort in which all GATT contracting parties contributed important concessions by way of increased market access, and by agreeing to new and improved rules for international trade. The Government of Canada would no doubt wish to keep this broader context in mind in considering possible adjustments to the Statement of Intent.
