5.	Title and number of pages of the notified document: Proposed Rule: Safety Standard for Bicycle Helmets (21 pages)
6.	Description of content: The Commission is proposing a safety standard that would require bicycle helmets to meet impact-attenuation and other requirements. In addition to requirements derived from one or more of the voluntary standards applicable to this product, the proposed standard includes requirements specifically applicable to children's helmets and requirements to prevent helmets from coming off during an accident. The Commission is also proposing testing and recordkeeping requirements so it can ensure that helmets subject to the standard meet its requirements.
