5.	Title and number of pages of the notified document: STN 74 4592 Flooring. Levelling Layers of Cast Anhydrite Coating
6.	<p>Description of content:</p> <p>STN 74 4592 determines methods of planning, lay down, and testing of cast anhydrite coatings, used as levelling flooring layers in the interiors of buildings.</p> <p>Obligatory articles:</p> <p>3.1.3 - requires to use plasticizers beforehand tested and approved by the Slovak Ministry of Health;</p> <p>6.3 - states the principles of safety and health protection while working with the plasticizers.</p>
7.	<p>Objective and rationale:</p> <p>STN 74 4592 was worked out because of introduction of the cast anhydrite technology in the Slovak Republic, produced from domestic material (anhydrite), with the possibility of exporting the anhydrite binding to foreign countries.</p>
