6.	Description of content: The exemption of vitamin preparations from the Food and Drugs Act has been in force in the Netherlands since 30 March 1994. This exemption regulation provides for the exemption from the ban to trade in vitamin preparations under certain conditions. One of these conditions is that the label on the external packaging shall specify the following: "een evenwichtige voeding bevat voldoende vitamines" (a balanced diet contains a sufficient intake of vitamins). However, regarding the vitamin folic acid, this appears to be incorrect. The obligation to use the above-mentioned specification can therefore not apply to a vitamin preparation whose main aim is to supply folic acid only. The draft has modified the present exemption regulation accordingly.

Objective and rationale: In the Netherlands, approximately 300 children are born every year with a neural tube defect: a deficient development of the nervous system, leading to, among other things, spina bifida. Various research has shown that the intake of the vitamin preparation folic acid can reduce the risk of such disorder by 50 per cent. The extra daily quantity of folio acid required is 0.4 to 0.5 milligrammes and is ideally administered in the form of tablets.
