Several sets of regulations are being amended to include the Canadian Environmental Protection Act definition of "biotechnology." The proposed amendments will clarify for the public, and the agricultural and food production industry, that biotechnology products are regulated under these sets of regulations in a similar manner to products derived through traditional technologies. Through this clarification, the proposed amendments will facilitate competitiveness of the Canadian agricultural biotechnology industry in the global marketplace. The amendments to the Health of Animals Regulations will clarify the intent to control animals or other organisms, into which a part of an animal pathogen has been introduced by biotechnological means. This will ensure that disease is not introduced into animals or the environment. 7. Objective and rationale: Protection of health
