ICS numbers may be provided in addition, where applicable): The starting materials i.e. all substances or compounds which, without being in themselves medicinal products within the meaning of Article 1 of the Law of 25 March 1964 on medicinal products, are procured by a dispensing chemist with a view to supplying them as they are or after dividing them or incorporating them in an officinal or magistral preparation
5.	Title and number of pages of the notified document: Royal Decree on the Control and Analysis of Starting Materials Used by Dispensing Chemists
6.	Description of content: The aim is to define the obligations of dispensing chemists with regard to the control of the above-mentioned starting materials and to ease the stipulated controls where these have been previously carried out by an authorized supplier.
7.	Objective and rationale: To encourage the use of high-quality starting materials for the preparation of officinal or magistral preparations
8.	Relevant documents: Replacement of an earlier Royal Decree annulled by the Council of State.
