ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification under Article 4

**Extension and Modification of the Bilateral Agreement
between Canada and the Philippines**

The Textiles Surveillance Body received a notification from Canada of an extension with modifications of its agreement with the Philippines beyond 1994 until such time as both the Philippines and Canada accede to the World Trade Organization, including the MTN Agreement on Textiles and Clothing.¹

The TSB, pursuant to its procedures regarding notifications received under Article 4,² has examined the relevant documentation and is forwarding the text of the notification to participating countries for their information.

This is to confirm the Canadian proposal regarding the extension beyond the end of 1994 of the Memorandum of Understanding between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Republic of the Philippines relating to the export from the Philippines of certain textiles and textile products for import into Canada (MOU).

The Canadian authorities propose that the attached documents entitled "Annex I - Restraint Levels", "Annex II - Preamble", "Annex II - Apparel Categories" and "Annex II - Textile Categories" replace Annex I and Annex II presently appended to the current MOU, effective 1 January 1995.

We also propose that the 1994 unadjusted restraint level for the current Agreement Item 7/8a be increased by 559,481 units to a new level of 1,275,656 units, which excludes children's wear. The 1994 unadjusted restraint level for Agreement Item 7/8 remains at 1,774,080 units, and the 1994 unadjusted restraint level for Agreement Item 7/8b remains unchanged at 205,654 units. We also propose that the 1994 adjustment to the current Agreement Item 7/8a together with the 1995 Agreement Items 7/8a and 8a and their corresponding unadjusted restraint levels, as proposed in Annex I, attached, be deemed to compensate fully the Philippine concerns for loss of flexibility due to the conversion to the HS in this group of products.

The Canadian authorities propose that this letter and the attached Annexes, along with a confirmation by the Philippine authorities of these proposals, constitute an agreement extending the MOU beyond 1994 until such time as both the Philippines and Canada accede to the World Trade Organization, including the MTN Agreement on Textiles and Clothing, and that the extension of the MOU beyond the end of 1994 apply to all terms and conditions in the current MOU, including growth rates and flexibility provisions.

ANNEX II - PREAMBLE

PHILIPPINES

1. Unless otherwise indicated, gender means garments for men (M), boys (B) (sizes 8 to 18), women (W), girls (G) (sizes 7 to 16), children (C) (sizes 2 to 6X) and babies, of a body height not exceeding 86 cm (sizes 0 to 24 months).
2. A partially manufactured textile article shall be taken to include an article unfinished or incomplete (including cut or shaped fabric for making such articles), provided that, as presented, the incomplete or unfinished article has the essential character of the complete or finished article. It shall also be taken to include the article presented unassembled or disassembled.
3. Garments of indeterminate gender, including unisex garments are to be counted as of female gender.
4. Unless otherwise indicated, products covered by restraints under this arrangement in Group I are those which predominate by weight of wool, cotton, or man-made fibres.
5. Baby garments of Category 14 put up in sets for retail sale will be counted as a set. A set comprises two or three matched (ensemble) or coordinated pieces, of the same construction, covering both the upper and lower parts of the body, and packed and shipped and sold as a set.

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This letter of acceptance by the Philippine authorities, together with its letter of 13 September 1994 and the attached Annexes, constitute an agreement extending the MOU beyond 1994 until such time that the Philippines and Canada accede to the World Trade Organization, including the MTN Agreement on Textiles and Clothing, and that the extension of the MOU beyond the end of 1994 apply to all terms and conditions in the current MOU, including growth rates and flexibility provisions.
