ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification under Article 4:4

Extension and Amendment of the Agreement between the United States and Jamaica

The Textiles Surveillance Body received a notification from the United States of an extension of its agreement with Jamaica for the period 1 January to 31 December 1993, and of an amendment of this extension.¹

The TSB pursuant to its procedures regarding notifications received under Article 4,² has examined the relevant documentation and is forwarding the text of the notification to participating countries for their information.

2. (Text of US Note)

The Department of State refers the Embassy of Jamaica to the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles, done at Geneva on 20 December 1973, as amended and extended (the Arrangement), and to the Agreement between the Governments of Jamaica and of the United States of America Concerning Trade in Cotton, Wool, and Man-made Fibre Textiles and Textile Products manufactured in Jamaica and exported to the United States, effected by Exchange of Notes 26 October and 1 November 1988, as amended (the Agreement).

The Department of State also refers to the proposal of the Government of Jamaica, conveyed in the diplomatic note of the Embassy of Jamaica, dated 27 November 1992 to extend the Agreement for one year through 31 December 1993. The Department of State is pleased to confirm that this proposal is acceptable to the Government of the United States of America and restates the contents of the diplomatic note of the Embassy of Jamaica below:

"The Embassy of Jamaica presents its compliments to the Department of State and has the honour to refer to the Agreement Relating to Trade in Textiles and Textile Products of Cotton, Wool, and Man-Made Fibre (the Agreement) between the Government of the United States and the Government of Jamaica, effected by exchange of notes October 16, 1988 and November 1, 1988, as amended.

The Government of Jamaica has the honour to propose an extension of the Agreement for an additional one year period, from January 1, 1993, to December 31, 1993. All provisions of the Agreement, as amended, will remain the same, with the exception of the following:

- 1. The first sentence of the first paragraph of the Agreement shall be amended to read "the term of this Agreement will be the period from September 1, 1986, through December 31, 1993."
- 2. Annex B shall be amended to include the period 1.1.93-12.31.93 at the same levels for the guaranteed access levels (GALS). These levels are:
