DEFINITION OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS

Addendum

The following notification was received from the Government of Sweden.

In accordance with procedures established at the meeting of the Committee on Agriculture on 17 April 1964, I have the honour to enclose a list of such tariff items outside the first twenty-four chapters of the Brussels Nomenclature which the Swedish Government proposes shall be regarded as agricultural products in the Kennedy negotiations. All these items are covered by the Swedish Agricultural Regulation system. The Swedish Government reserves its right to propose at a later stage any additions to the list.

- ex 35.02 Ovalbumin
- 35.05 Dextrin, soluble or roasted starches; starch glues
- 35.06 Prepared glues not elsewhere specified or included; products suitable for use as glues put up for sale by retail as glues in packages not exceeding a net weight of one kilogramme
- ex 38.12 Prepared glazings, prepared dressings and prepared mordants of a kind used in the textile paper, leather or like industries
Preparations with a basis of starchy substances (such as wheat starch, rice starch, maize starch, potato starch and dextrine)
- ex 38.19 Chemical products and preparations of the chemical or allied industries (including those consisting of mixtures of natural products) not elsewhere specified or included, residual products of the chemical or allied industries not elsewhere specified or included. Foundry core binders based on products other than natural resinous products, with a content of dextrin or molasses

- 54.01 Flax, raw or processed but not spun; flax tow and waste (including pulled or garnetted rags)
- 57.01 True hemp (cannabis sativa) raw or processed but not spun; tow and waste of true hemp (including pulled or garnetted rags or ropes)
- ex 57.04 Other vegetable textile fibres, raw or processed but not spun; waste of such fibres (including pulled or garnetted rags or ropes)
Hemp other than Manila hemp.
