Communication from India

The following communication has been received from the delegation of India.

In accordance with the recommendation of the Trade Negotiations Committee, I enclose a list of items which are of special interest in the export trade of India. The exclusion of these items from the exceptions lists of the developed countries participating in the Kennedy Round of trade negotiations is thus specially important to us and we would wish to see these items not included in their exceptions lists. The enclosed list has been drawn up in a preliminary manner and if, as a result of further study, some more items have to be added to the list, I will communicate the additional items to you later.
