Communication from Indonesia

The following communication has been received from the delegation of Indonesia.

In the light of the ministerial Decision and the principles adopted by the Trade Negotiations Committee relating to the participation of less-developed contracting parties, I have the honour to inform you that the Government of the Republic of Indonesia intends to participate in the Kennedy trade negotiations.

In this connexion I am instructed to submit to you the following list of products of export interest to my Government:

- Rubber and rubber products
- Petroleum and petroleum products
- Tin and tin products
- Vegetable oils and oilseeds
- Coconut (copra) and coconut products
- Tea, coffee, cocoa, tobacco, tropical spices, tapioca, manioc, sugar
- Forestry products
- Hides and skins
- Handicrafts and cottage industry products
- Mineral products
- Etherical oils
- Materials (raw, processed or semi-processed) for medical purposes
- Live animals.
