Communication from the Dominican Republic

The delegation of the Dominican Republic has sent the secretariat the following communication.

On behalf of my dovernment, I have the honour of forwarding herewith a list of products of special export interest to the Dominican Republic.

In accordance with the decision of the Sub-Committee on the Participation of the Less-Developed Countries, this list is transmitted to you in order to inform contracting parties of those products which are of special export interest to our country so that they shall not be included in the exceptions lists submitted by the industrialized countries participating in the Kennedy Round. Our Government likewise hopes that these products will enjoy in so far as possible a reduction of more than 50 per cent.
