Communication from Malta

The following communication has been received from the Government of Malta.

I have the honour to refer to my letter of 14 April 1965 (TN.64/52) wherein we notified Malta's intention to participate in the Kennedy Round.

As we have not yet informed the Trade Negotiations Committee of the items of export interest to Malta, I am listing hereunder the products concerned, which are identical to those notified to the Committee on Trade and Development on 10 June 1965, which my Government would not wish to see included in the exceptions lists of developed countries participating in the Kennedy Round negotiations, namely,
