L/1732	Report of Committee III adopted on 16 November 1962. Recommends establishment of a Special Group on Trade in Tropical Products. (Subsequently established by the Council in February 1962.)
L/1817	Record of Discussions and Conclusions Reached at the Meeting of the Special Group held from 4-8 June 1962. <u>Inter alia</u> , Group agrees to establish Sub-Group to examine certain aspects of the problems discussed, sets up terms of reference. The work should relate in the first instance to cocoa, coffee, tea, vegetable seeds and oils, tropical timber and bananas.

L/1952	Record of Discussions at Meeting of Sub-Group, from 3-6 December 1962. Contains outline of work to be done by the secretariat.
