I. LIVE CATTLE, BEEF AND VEAL, OTHER MEATS AND PROCESSED MEATS

A. Observations

If prices obtained in the export market are lower than those in the home market, the difference is usually covered by payments out of the Feed Concentrate Fund, which is financed by levies on feeding stuffs. There are no State subsidies on meat exports.

II. DAIRY PRODUCTS

A. Observations

1. Losses on exports are covered by payments out of the Feed Concentrate Fund which is financed by levies on feeding stuffs. There are no State subsidies on exports of dairy products.
2. Export assistance for butter and cheese is equal to the difference between an f.o.b. basic export price and the obtained f.o.b. price.
3. In the case of exports of milk powder and condensed milk, the export assistance corresponds to the difference between the domestic unit value of the milk used for processing and the value obtained by export of the product.
