## 3. Type of restrictions:

- DL: Discretionary licensing.
- ST: State trading.
- K: Products marked with this symbol remain under administrative protection for reasons of <u>Kashruth</u> (Jewish Dietary Law).

Products, imports of which are subject to automatic licensing, have not been listed.
