HS: Kernels of quinces, apricots, peaches, plums and prunes

An import permit, granted automatically, is necessary in order to ensure that plants obtained from the above-mentioned kernels undergo the Swiss phytosanitary check. It is forbidden to put them into circulation without an official check. These provisions do not apply to imports for pharmaceutical use.
