Revised MFN Exemption List of Bolivia

The following communication is circulated at the request of Bolivia to the members of the Group of Negotiations on Services.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Bolivia to the United Nations Office and other international organizations at Geneva presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Group of Negotiations on Services and has the honour to attach its revised list of exemptions to Article II in accordance with the draft General Agreement on Trade in Services, prepared on the basis of the new agreed model.

In addition, it confirms that Bolivia's offer concerning initial commitments is that which appears in document MTN.GNS/W/147.
