Maritime transport	Maritime transport traffic on scheduled services between Morocco and other countries is shared in accordance with the Code of Conduct for Liner Conferences.	All countries	Indefinite	Morocco has signed the Code of Conduct for Liner Conferences in order to allow the sector to develop and to increase exports of goods.
International road transport	Measures contained in existing and future bilateral or multilateral agreements on the international road transportation of passengers and goods.	All countries	Indefinite	International road transport is a recent activity in Morocco. The signature of bilateral agreements is aimed at protecting national enterprises by guaranteeing them a market share on the one hand and on the other at promoting bilateral co-operation among professionals.
