Agreement on Trade in Civil Aircraft:  
Statistical Reporting on Trade Data

The Swedish external trade statistics are based on information collected by the customs authorities in conjunction with the imports and exports of goods. The National Central Bureau of Statistics publishes monthly data on commodities (items in the national commodity list, based on the CCC Nomenclature) with breakdown by country of origin and country of consumption under each item.

The products covered by the Agreement on Trade in Civil Aircraft have not been given separate statistical numbers in the Swedish customs tariff. It is therefore not possible to provide trade data for such products solely. Enclosed you will find a list of the few items already existing in the Swedish customs tariff which are covered by the Agreement and which entirely consist of aircraft products (i.e. no ex-items). Please note, however, that the figures include military as well as civil aircraft products. For remaining items under the Agreement the available trade data thus cover both aircraft and other products.
