REVIEW OF THE SCHEDULES OF CONCESSIONS

Note by the Secretariat

1. The Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries is an autonomous preferential trading arrangement providing for an exchange of mutually advantageous tariff and trade concessions among the signatory countries. The Protocol was signed in 1971 at the conclusion of the initial round of negotiations carried out in the Trade Negotiations Committee of Developing Countries. This Committee was open to all developing countries whether or not members of GATT. The Protocol entered into force on 11 February 1973 following the grant of a waiver by the CONTRACTING PARTIES and acceptance of the Protocol by more than half of the countries participating in the negotiations. This waiver related only to the provisions of paragraph 1 of Article I. Its place has now been taken by the Decisión on Differential and More Favourable Treatment which covers also reduction and elimination among less developed contracting parties of non-tariff measures subject to any criteria that may be prescribed.

2. The signatory countries and the year of entry into force of the Protocol are as follows:

Bangladesh (1977), Brazil (1973), Chile (1974), Egypt (1973), Greece (1974; withdrawal 1980), India (1973), Israel (1973), Republic of Korea (1973), Mexico (1974), Pakistan (1973), Paraguay (ratification pending), Peru (1976), Philippines (ratification pending), Romania (1978), Spain (1973), Tunisia (1973), Turkey (1973), Uruguay (1975), Yugoslavia (1973).

Pursuant to paragraphs 5 and 6 of the Protocol, the Committee of Participating Countries is expected to keep under review the arrangements under the Protocol taking into account the objectives set out in the Preamble. The Committee is also required to review the possibility of promoting negotiations for additions or enlargements to the schedules of concessions and may at any time sponsor such negotiations.

4. A major review of the operation of the Protocol took place in 1978. On this occasion, the Committee of Participating Countries, inter alia, emphasized the importance of continuing the arrangements under the Protocol and concluded that the five-year experience of the operation of the

Protocol had been encouraging and provided a basis for the expectation that the further enlargement of the arrangement in terms of membership and coverage would make a substantial contribution to a further significant broadening of the area of trade cooperation among developing countries.

5. At its meeting on 14 October 1982, the Committee of Participating Countries requested the secretariat to prepare necessary factual material that would serve as a basis for action directed at updating and improving the general level of mutually beneficial concessions under the Protocol.

6. The following tabulations have been prepared on the basis of the latest information available in the secretariat with respect to tariffs and trade flows on concessional items among participating countries and may be revised in the light of comments by delegations.

7. In addition to indicating the current tariff number and product description, the tables indicate 1971 and current m.f.n. tariff rates, other relevant charges and taxes, tariff concessions and initial negotiating rights under the Protocol¹, as well as imports of concessional items by participating countries in 1973 (or the earliest period for which data is available) and 1979, 1980 and 1981 (or the latest period for which data is available).

8. Below are some preliminary and factual comments based on the tabulations annexed:

- (i) The initial negotiations took place on the basis of item-by-item requests and offers. The concessions were also limited to tariff preferences expressed as a reduced rate of duty or as a percentage of the m.f.n. rate or a fixed margin below the m.f.n. rate. Except in two instances, no understandings were negotiated with respect to licensing regimes, though the Protocol provides that consultations might take place where an intensification of balance-of-payments restrictions results in a nullification of benefits.
- (ii) The lists of concessions also cover a limited number of items, and the scope of the concessions is in many cases quite modest both in terms of the volume of the trade of each participating country covered and the tariff reductions granted.
- (iii) Nevertheless, available statistics indicate a steady rate of growth on mutual trade in concessional items among reporting participating countries. In 1980, the value of mutual trade among fourteen participating countries in the items subject to concessions was approximately US\$538 million, an increase over the preceding year of approximately 30 per cent.

- (iv) A positive factor for the development of trade under the Protocol has been the decision by all participating countries to implement and maintain in operation the concessions originally negotiated with the Philippines and Greece even though the concessions given by these countries are not in force or have been withdrawn.
- (v) For most participating countries trade in concessional items has concentrated on a limited number of products, often imported from participating countries other than the original negotiator. For many items subject to concessions, there have been large imports into participating countries from non-participating countries. In both cases, it would be reasonable to conclude that the problem has related more to the lack of export availability in the participating countries and other obstacles to trade which the preferential concession has not sufficed to overcome, than the lack of import opportunities in the market of participating country giving the concession even though these opportunities may in certain instances have been affected by import substitution.
- (vi) A point worthy of note is that, in general, trade flows in concessional items have evolved more or less in parallel with global trade exchanges between the participating countries. In some instances imports originating in participating countries, in both concessional and non-concessional items, have continued to increase notwithstanding a general decline in the global imports of the country concerned. This would suggest that at the very least the exchange of concessions under the Protocol has resulted in greater information about and interest in the markets that participating countries offer to one another, the benefits of which have not been confined to the items which have been the subject of concessions.
- (vii) For a number of items, the preferential tariff rate not only represents a relatively small concession in terms of the additional price margin made available to the supplier, its benefits have also been diluted by permissible increases in surcharges, import taxes or balance-of-payments restrictions. It may be noted that while over the period covered by these tabulations, some countries have moved towards overall reduction of m.f.n. rates, thus reducing preferential margins, other countries have been forced to tighten significantly the overall restrictiveness of their import regimes under the impact of recession and growing balance-of-payments deficits.

9. In order to arrive at more definitive conclusions, it would be necessary to secure more up-to-date and detailed information on the precise changes in the import regimes of the participating countries by way of adjustment in m.f.n. tariffs, import taxes and surcharges as well as import restrictions that have taken place. It would also be necessary to carry out a more detailed examination of other factors that could have played a role in the evolution of trade exchanges, such as the availability of financing facilities including export credits, shipping and marketing links etc., between the participating countries.
