## MEMORANDUM:

### Australia-Finland

In conformity with the procedure prescribed in G.A.T.T./TM.1/A/1, the Australian Delegation wishes to inform the Secretariat that representatives of Australia and Finland met at 11.30 a.m. on 12th May and held their first tariff negotiations meeting following the exploratory talks held on 6th May.

On both sides offers were made on one or two items which are also the subject of negotiations with other countries.

The negotiations between Finland and Australia may be regarded as concluded although, on the Australian side, the offers have been made subject to confirmation by Canberra.

We propose to defer formal circulation of the Australian offer until confirmation is received from Canberra.

## Australia - Finland.

In a memorandum dated 12th May the Australian delegation informed the Secretariat that Australia and Finland held their first tariff negotiations meeting on 17th May and that the negotiations could be regarded as concluded pending confirmation from Canberra.

We also advised that it was proposed to defer formal circulation of the Australian offer until it had been confirmed by Canberra.

Canberra has since confirmed the offer. Two copies (for the use of the Secretariat) accompany this note.



In conformity with the procedure set forth in document GATT/TN1/16 we, the leaders of the delegations of Australia and Finland, have pleasure in informing the Secretariat that agreement has been reached in the tariff negotiations between the two countries.

We enclose two documents, in duplicate.
