Sir,

Italy and Canada have had a number of tariff discussions and have now exchanged final offers of the tariff concessions which we have agreed to make to each other. There are attached a list of offers by Italy to Canada and a list of offers by Canada to Italy; these lists contain the tariff concessions agreed upon between us.

It has further been agreed that the following offer, made by Italy, shall be added to the list of Italian final offers to Canada:

In accordance with the provisions of Article II, paragraph 4, of the General Agreement on Tariff and Trade, the resale price for each crop year of wheat, which is the product of any of the territories of contracting parties and which is imported by the Italian government or its agents, exclusive of internal taxes, transportation, distribution and other expenses incident to the purchase and sale, and a reasonable margin of profit, shall not exceed by more than 15%, the average landed cost, duty-paid of wheat of comparable kind and quality, the product of such territories imported during the previous crop year; provided however, that the domestic selling price of such imported wheat shall not be required to be reduced in any crop year by more than 20 per cent below prices of the previous crop year.

Our discussions have been both informative and helpful and we are confident that both countries will benefit by the tariff concessions
