The Uruguayan and Canadian delegations have had several tariff discussions and have agreed upon a number of reciprocal concessions. There are attached a list of offers by Uruguay to Canada and a list of offers by Canada to Uruguay; these lists contain the tariff concessions agreed upon between us,

It has further been agreed that if Canada makes any concessions to any other country participating in the Annecy tariff negotiations on the two tariff items listed below, such concessions shall be also added to the list of Canadian concessions to Uruguay.
