With regard to your remarks at the meeting yesterday of the Tariff Negotiations Working Party, I wish to confirm we are in agreement that no useful purpose would be served by bi-lateral negotiations between Canada and Uruguay at this conference other than those arising out of adjustments made under Article XXVIII.
