Ingrid Sinclair is the Global President of Sims Lifecycle Services (SLS). Her oversight covers all operational and revenue responsibilities for recycling services offered by the company. Ingrid routinely advocates for expanding recycling initiatives through innovation, fair and consistent trade practices and responsibly managing transboundary movement of e-waste. Ingrid's international experience in compliance and her extensive recycling expertise has qualified her as a contributor to both the G7 (France – 2019) as well as the International E-Waste Day (India – 2020) discussing such important topics as sustainable e-waste management and enabling the circular economy. Throughout her career, Ingrid has spearheaded innovation in the electronics recycling industry. As part of the executive leadership team of Sims Limited, she helped define the organization's purpose, to create a world without waste to preserve our planet. In recent years, as President of SLS, she has championed a closed loop plastic project with Hewlett Packard Inc. (HPI). This project represents a major step forward in sustainable electronics recycling, enabling HPI to recover plastic from recycled printers and directly reuse the recovered material to manufacture new printers. Ingrid was appointed to the position of Global President of Sims Lifecycle Services in 2019. She was the first woman selected as a divisional president of any of the Sims' divisions. Ingrid has been in the electronics recycling industry for over 20 years, starting her career in this field as a process engineer at the Glencore Canada (formerly Noranda) copper and precious metal refinery in Montreal, Quebec. In addition to being trained as a Six Sigma Black Belt, Ingrid has a bachelor's degree in Chemical Engineering from University of Ottawa and a Master of Business Administration from Concordia University. Ingrid enjoys dual citizenship in the U.S. and Canada and is fluent in French.
