


World Production & Mill Use






Share of Trade in World Production




Cotton Exports by Country







Share of Exports in Production 2014/15















World Cotton Mill Use 1982/83





World Cotton Mill Use 2014/15



World Consumption of Textile Fibers









World Cotton Consumption and Market Share of Cotton
