Honourable Ministers,
Chairperson of the General Council,

Delivering these results also enhances trust and confidence in multilateralism, which is particularly valuable given the testing and uncertain times we find ourselves in.
- With the adopted Abu Dhabi Package we have demonstrated that we can work together, cooperate and deliver – mindful of our shared interests and collective responsibility. We can certainly be proud of arriving at the Abu Dhabi Package of Outcomes!
- Excellencies, I thank you all for your participation in the Thirteenth Session of the Ministerial Conference. It has been a true honour and privilege to host you here in Abu Dhabi.
