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Notes to the Appendix:

1. All tables in this Appendix have been updated to 1 January 1995 unless otherwise indicated.
2. In table I, the date referred to indicates the date of acquisition of contracting party status, whether by acceptance of Protocol of Provisional Application, by accession under Article XXIII, or by succession to contracting party status under Article XXVI:5(c).
3. Table II lists governments applying the General Agreement *de facto*. Concerning *de facto* application of the GATT, see the discussion at pages 855-856. Any such government may succeed to contracting party status under Article XXVI:5(c) upon certification by the Director-General that the conditions required by this Article have been met: see the discussion at pages 853-854. Governments having succeeded to contracting party status under Article XXVI:5(c) are listed in table VI(C).
4. Tables III, IV and V list members of and observers in the Council, and observers to sessions of the CONTRACTING PARTIES. See the discussion of observer status at pages 1009-1010 and 1017-1019. C. SUCCESSION TO CONTRACTING PARTY STATUS UNDER ARTICLE XXVI:5(C)

The simplified procedures for the acquisition of contracting party status under Article XXVI:5(c) adopted in 1963 provide for a certification by the Director-General to the effect that the conditions of Article XXVI:5(c) have been fulfilled and advising that the government concerned has become a contracting party. The rights and obligations of contracting parties acceding under Article XXVI:5(c) date from the date of independence of the newly-independent State or the date of a territory's autonomy in the conduct of its external commercial relations as certified by the "responsible contracting party" under Article XXVI:5(c). - (SCM)** Agreement on Interpretation and Application of Articles VI, XVI and XXIII of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, 26S/56, 1186 UNTS 204.
- (LIC)** Agreement on Import Licensing Procedures, 26S/154, 1186 UNTS 372.
- (AIR)** Agreement on Trade in Civil Aircraft, 26S/162, 1186 UNTS 170; the Annex to this Agreement was amended by the Protocol (1986) Amending the Annex to the Agreement on Trade in Civil Aircraft, 34S/22, ... UNTS ..., which entered into force on 1 January 1988.
- (TBT)** Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade, 26S/8, 1186 UNTS 276.

2. *Agreements which entered into force on 1 January 1981:*

- (VAL)** Agreement on Implementation of Article VII of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, 26S/116, 1235 UNTS 126, and Protocol to the Agreement on Implementation of Article VII of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, 26S/151, 1235 UNTS 238, done at Geneva on 1 November 1979; upon entry into force of the Agreement on 1 January 1981, the provisions of the Protocol were deemed to be an integral part of the Agreement.
- (GPR)** Agreement on Government Procurement, 26S/33, 1235 UNTS 258; this agreement was amended by the Protocol Amending the Agreement on Government Procurement, 34S/12, ... UNTS ..., which entered into force on 14 February 1988 upon its acceptance by all Parties to the Agreement.

In addition, the following two agreements, done in 1979, were open for acceptance by governments members of the United Nations, or of one of its specialized agencies, and by the European Economic Community. These agreements have now terminated. Information on acceptances of these agreements can be found in previous editions of this book or in the *GATT Status of Legal Instruments*.

Arrangement Regarding Bovine Meat, 26S/84, 1186 UNTS 344. On 15 April at Marrakesh, Morocco, the International Bovine Meat Agreement was opened for acceptance; Article VI:1(c) of this Agreement provides that acceptance thereof carries denunciation of the Arrangement Regarding Bovine Meat effective on the date of entry into force of the Agreement Establishing the WTO. On 17 June 1994, the International Meat Council composed of the signatories to the Arrangement decided to extend the Arrangement only until the date of entry into force of the Agreement Establishing the WTO and the International Bovine Meat Agreement, and decided that the Arrangement Regarding Bovine Meat would terminate as of that date. The Arrangement duly terminated on 1 January 1995.

International Dairy Arrangement, 26S/91, 1186 UNTS 54. Acceptance of the International Dairy Arrangement carried denunciation of the Arrangement Concerning Certain Dairy Products done in 1970, and the Protocol Relating to Milk Fat, done in 1973. All parties to the 1970 Arrangement and the 1973 Protocol had accepted the 1979 Arrangement or otherwise withdrawn. On 15 April at Marrakesh, Morocco, the International Dairy Agreement was opened for acceptance; Article VIII:1(c) of this Agreement provides that acceptance thereof carries denunciation of the International Dairy Arrangement effective on the date of entry into force of the Agreement Establishing the WTO. In September 1994 the International Dairy Products Council composed of the signatories to the Arrangement decided to extend the Arrangement only until the date of entry into force of the Agreement Establishing the WTO and the International Dairy Agreement, and decided that the International Dairy Arrangement would terminate as of that date. The Arrangement duly terminated on 1 January 1995.

¹Also open for acceptance by governments having provisionally acceded to the GATT, and open to accession by any other government on terms to be agreed between that government and the parties to the agreement in question.
