

Over **1,800** titles published by the WTO or co-published with other international organizations, comprising almost **14,500** chapters.



Over **320** WTO working papers.



Over **850** dispute settlement reports.



Over **30** WTO titles co-published with Cambridge University Press, comprising over **500** chapters.



A WTO jurisprudence tool organized by WTO Agreement and updated every three months (WTO Analytical Index).



WTO Stats portal covering trade in goods and services (annual, quarterly and monthly), tariffs, non-tariff information and other indicators.



A gateway to **25** databases giving access to key information on measures relevant to global trade.




Content is made available in a variety of digital formats, including PDF, HTML, Excel and CSV.



Enriched metadata makes the content fully searchable, meaning users can drill down easily to their specific areas of interest.


Key features

- Content can be viewed by country, topic, language, year and title.
- A citation tool allows content to be easily integrated into bibliographic references.
- All content can be fully downloaded or copied/pasted for reuse elsewhere.



- All content is broken down by chapter.

- Each publication page contains a link to the WTO's Online Bookshop for ordering printed copies.



- A Read Online feature allows users to read and share content on all connected devices: desktop and mobile.

- Users have unlimited access to subscribed content.

- Free inclusion of content in course packs without the need to request permission.

- Content is available in English, French and Spanish.

Trade Policy Reviews

Monitoring of national trade policies is a fundamentally important activity running throughout the work of the WTO. At the centre of this work is the Trade Policy Review Mechanism (TPRM). All WTO members are reviewed; the frequency of each member's review varying according to its share of world trade. For each review, two documents are prepared: a policy statement by the government under review, and a detailed report written independently by the WTO Secretariat. These two reports, together with the conclusions of the Chair of the Trade Policy Review Body, are published shortly after the meeting.
