MONTHLY TRADE TRENDS: SEPTEMBER 2022 - OCTOBER 2022



MERCHANDISE TRADE

UPDATED ON 20 DECEMBER 2022

Merchandise exports growth slowed in all economies in October 2022. The United States of America recorded the strongest year-on-year growth of merchandise exports (10%) while the Republic of Korea recorded a negative growth (-6%) in the latest month. On the import side, Japan registered the highest growth (18%) while China's imports declined.

TRADE IN COMMERCIAL SERVICES

India showed the highest growth of exports of commercial service (25%) in October 2022. On the import side, the United Kingdom, Japan and the Republic of Korea recorded negative growth, while the United states of America's imports rose by 19%.
