

Global services trade posted an 18% yearon-year increase in the second quarter of 2022. Services trade continues to be bolstered by the strength of other commercial services trade.

In the second quarter of 2022, services trade showed positive year-on-year growth in all regions. On the export side, Other regions grew by 41% in the second quarter of 2022, year-on-year. On the import side, Other regions grew by 40% and North America increased by 31% year-on-year.



SECTORAL PERFORMANCE

World transport services rose 34% and world travel services increased 105% year-on-year in the second quarter of 2022 as pandemic-related restrictions have eased. Goods-related services increased by 10% year-on-year and other commercial services rose 2%. The modest growth seen in other commercial services, which is comprised of services such as computer services and insurance services, is due to the relatively limited decline it experienced during the pandemic.
