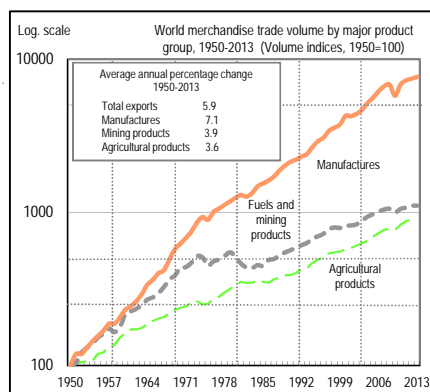
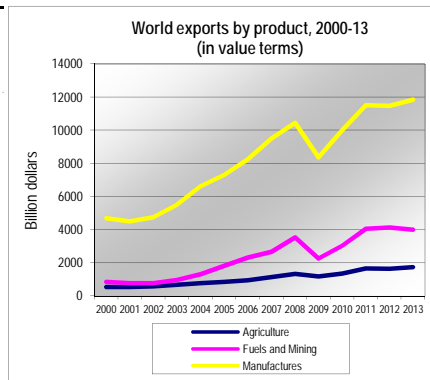
Exports of merchandise products of world and regions by destination, 2013 (Note: Value ranges differ by region.)



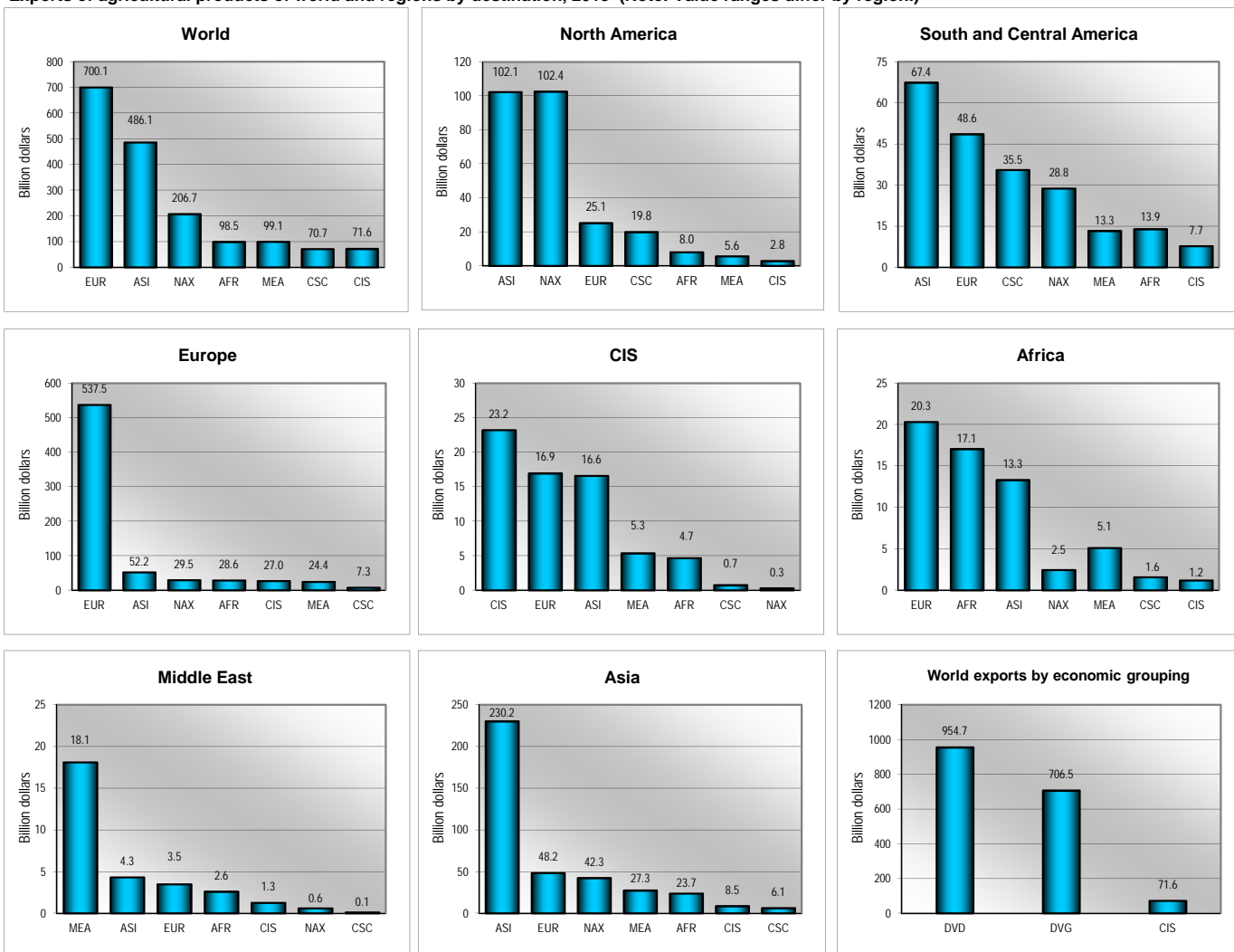

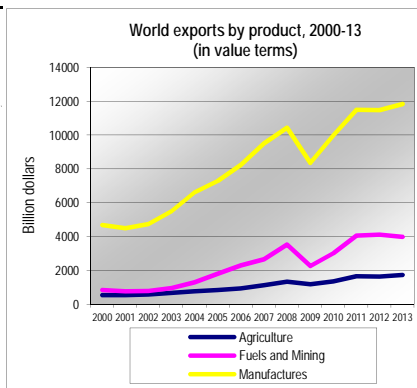
Exports of agricultural products of world and regions by destination, 2013 (Note: Value ranges differ by region.)



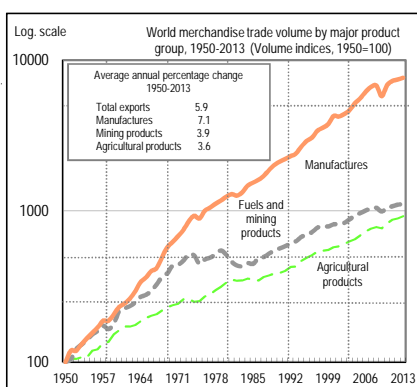

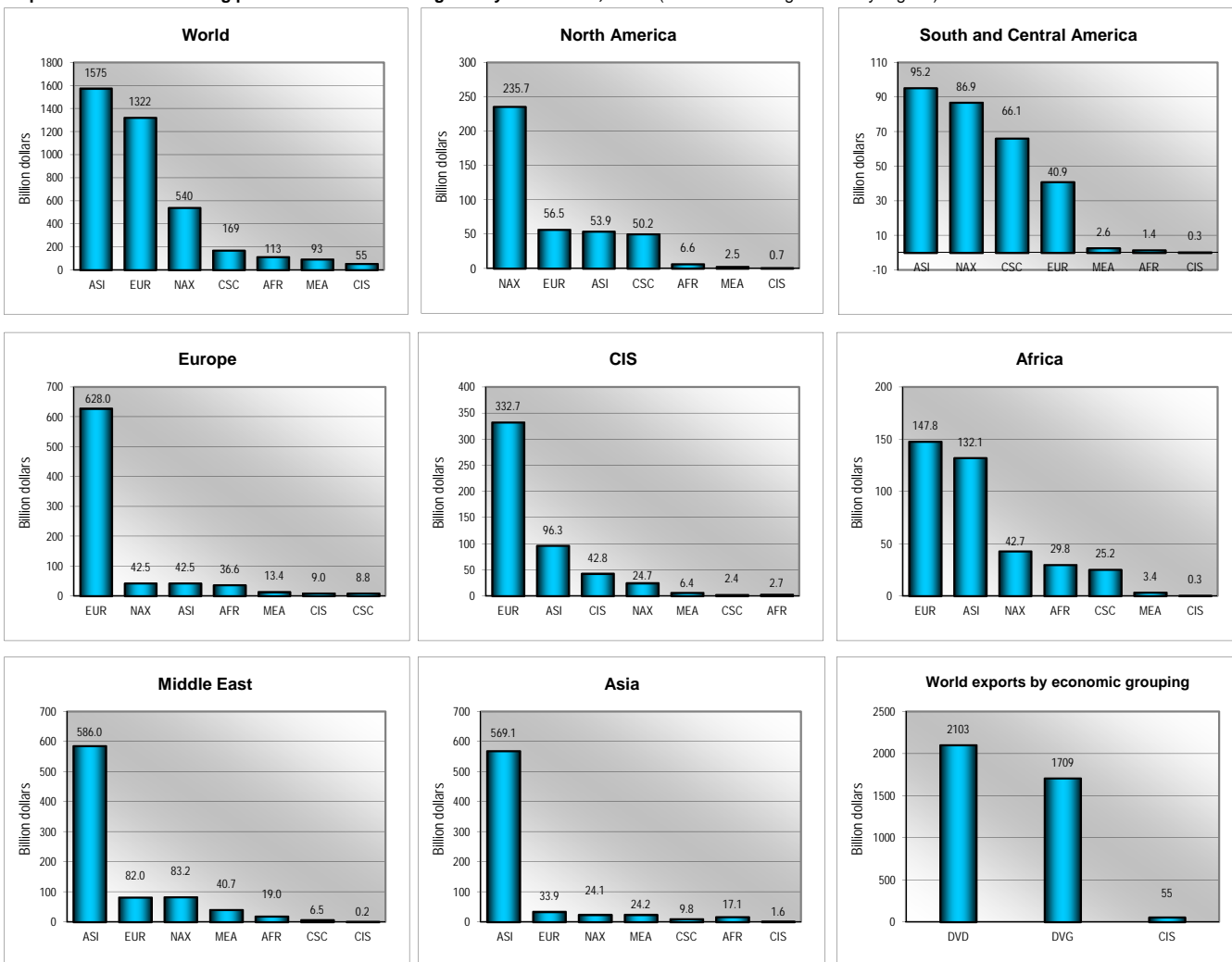

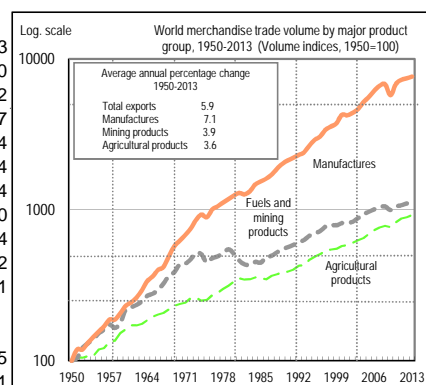
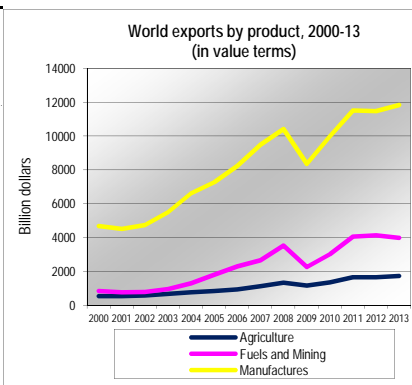
Exports of fuels and mining products of world and regions by destination, 2013 (Note: Value ranges differ by region.)



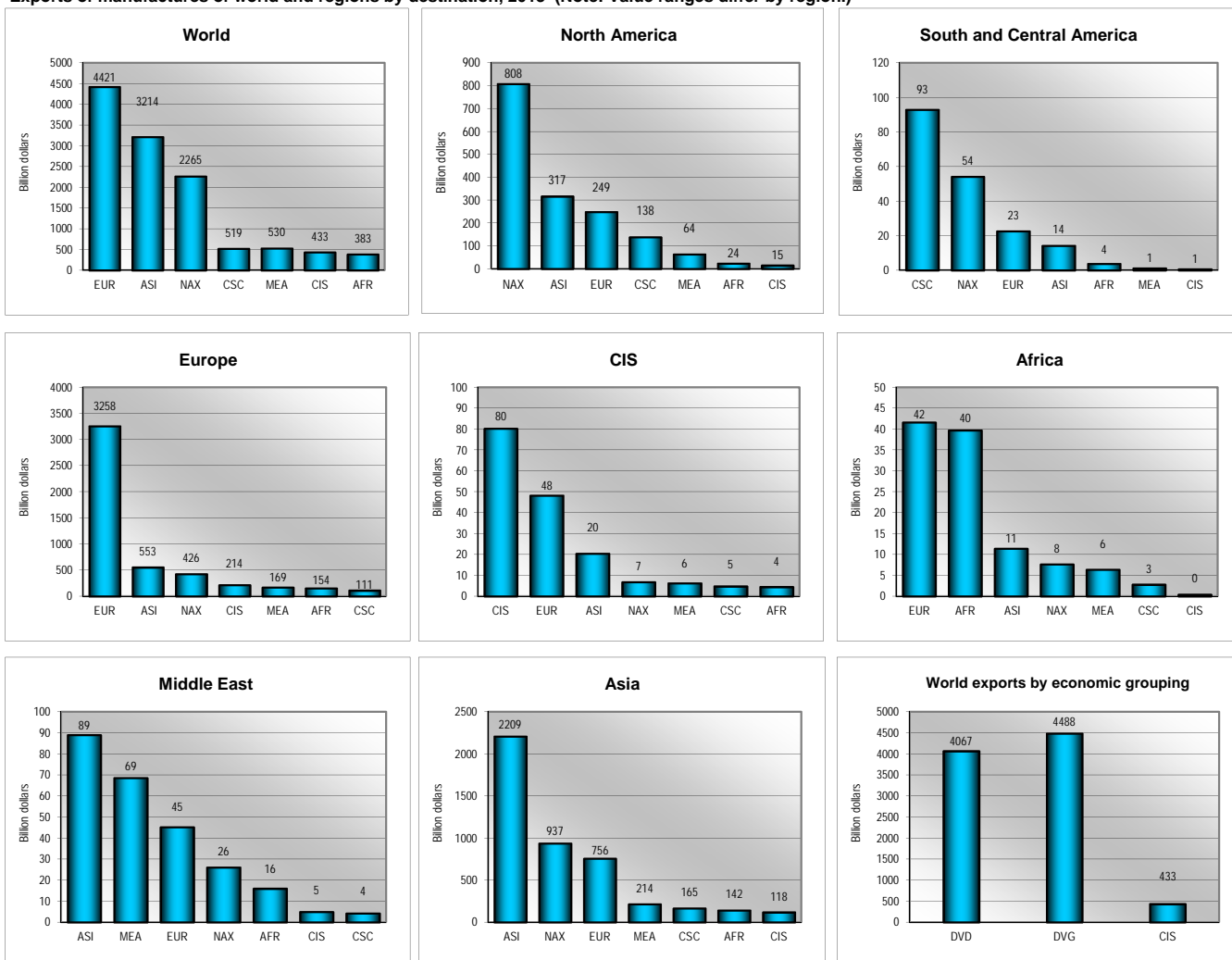
