María Pérez Esteve has been working in the Accessions Division at the World Trade Organization (WTO) since 2018. The work of the division is to facilitate the negotiations between WTO members and states and entities requesting accession to the WTO. The division encourages the integration into the multilateral trading system of those seeking to join the organization through the effective liberalization of their trade regimes in goods and services.

Previously she served at the WTO in the Council and Trade Negotiations Committee Division (2012- 2018), the Information and External Relations Division (2006-2012), and the Agriculture and Commodities Division (2002-2006).

Ms Pérez Esteve has been involved in international trade matters since 1999. Before joining the WTO, she worked as Economic Affairs Officer at the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) where she dealt with trade, environment and development issues.

Ms Pérez Esteve holds a bachelor's degree in Political Science and French Literature from the University of Illinois and a master's degree in Political Science and International Relations from the University of Geneva.
