So far, I have prepared draft speaking notes and drafted reports of meetings. I have also proofread and edited legal documents.

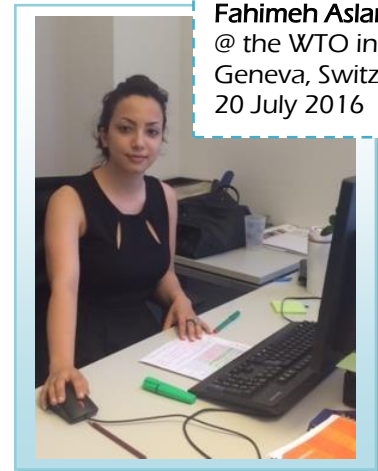
What do you think of your work/experience at the WTO so far?
