

**DECREE No 15**

**of the Government of the Republic of Armenia**

**of January 16, 1998**

**Yerevan**

**On Compulsory Certification of Goods and**

**Services in the Republic of Armenia**

In order to provide the safety of the products and services for human life and health of the population and for the natural environment, as well as to protect the consumers' rights the Government of the Republic of Armenia, according to the Armenian Law on "Standardisation and Certification", decides:

1. To establish:

- a) the lists of products and services subject to compulsory certification in the Republic of Armenia;
- b) the order of import to the Armenian customs territory of products subject to compulsory certification in the Republic of Armenia;
- c) the order of realisation of certified products (service supply) subject to compulsory certification in the Republic of Armenia and the rules of application of certificates of conformity in advertisements;
- d) the order of payment for compulsory certification in the Republic Armenia.

2. To determine:

- a) the compulsory certification of products and services in the Republic of Armenia is conducted in the frame of National Certification System of the Republic of Armenia according to national basic standards of AST 5 series;
- b) the rules of compulsory certification in the Republic of Armenia are defined by the Department of Standardisation, Metrology and Certification concerted with all interested Ministries and Departments.

3. The Ministry of Post and Communications of the Republic of Armenia together with the Department of Standardisation, Metrology and Certification should present to the Government of Armenia their offer on the list of communication means subject to compulsory certification.

4. The Department of Standardisation, Metrology and Certification of the Republic of Armenia should publish in media, including its official newspaper:

- a) the list of national certification bodies and test laboratories in Armenia, indicating the fields of their accreditation (twice a year);

b) the list of National Certification Systems of those countries, which have agreements with the Department of Standardisation, Metrology and Certification on mutual recognition of the results of certification (twice a year).

5. The Customs Department of the Republic of Armenia should provide the Department of Standardisation, Metrology and Certification with monthly information on imported goods subject to compulsory certification in the Republic of Armenia.

6. To recognize as invalid the Decree of the Government of the Republic of Armenia on “Compulsory Certification of Products in the Republic of Armenia” of 6 September, 1994 (wording of the Decree No 205 of the Armenian Government of 4 July, 1996, and Decree No 136 of the Armenian Government of 17 May, 1997).

7. This Decree is enforced on 16 January, 1998.
