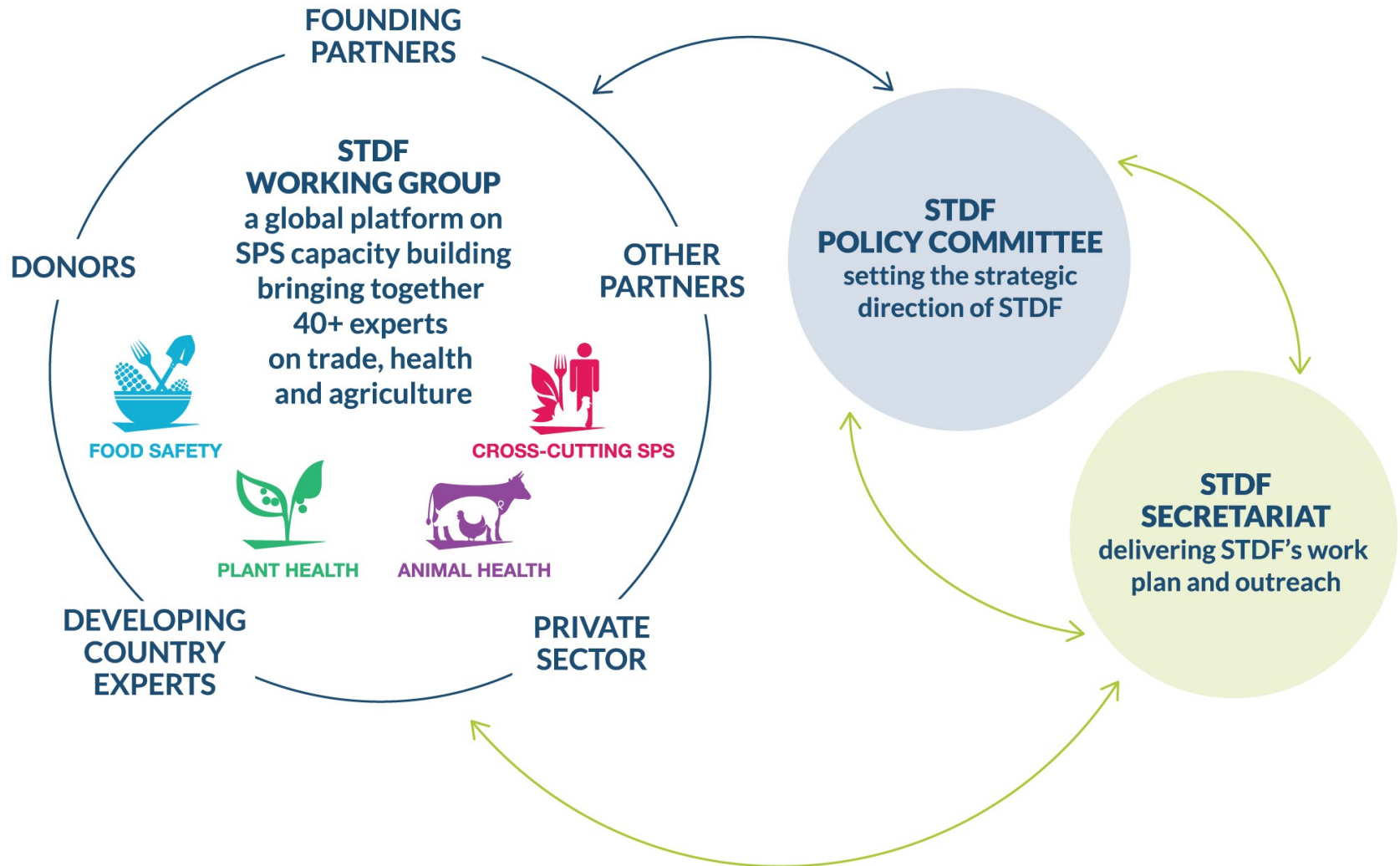

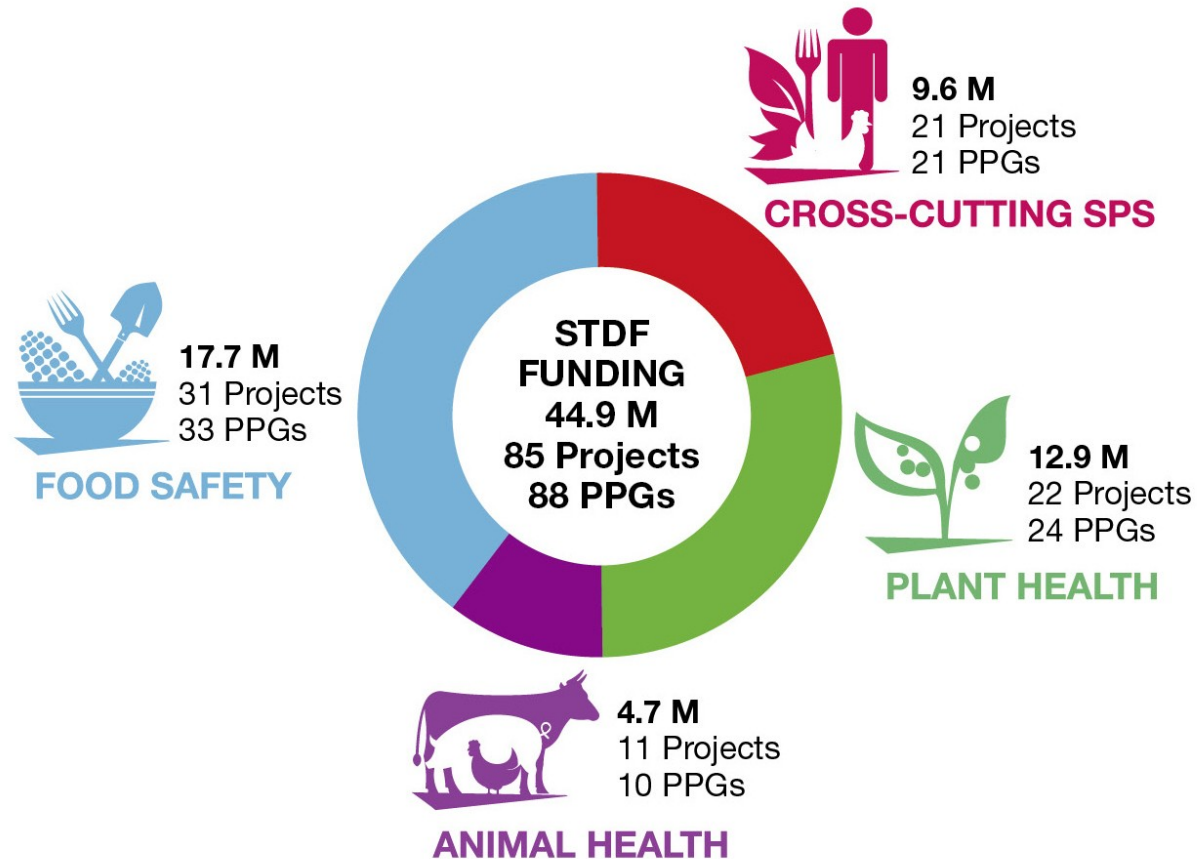


Good practice on latest SPS solutions

- innovative, collaborative, inter-disciplinary

Azerbaijan: Strengthening phytosanitary border controls

Expected results:

- Strengthened pest diagnostics services
- Improved management of the import regulatory system (strengthen collaboration between the Phytosanitary Control Service and Customs)
- Improved pre-border inspection and export certification system

limits of pesticides ..

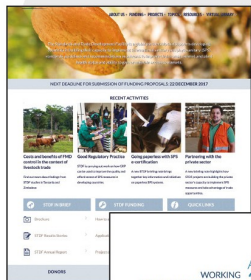

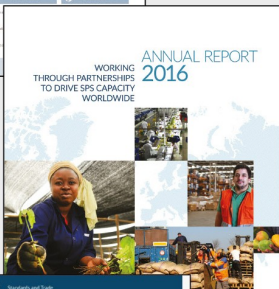
