## DECISION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION NO. 18 OF JANUARY 5, 1999

## ON THE ADDITIONAL MEASURES FOR THE STATE REGULATION IN THE PROCUREMENT, REALIZATION AND EXPORT OF THE WOOD OF PRECIOUS FOREST SPECIES

For the purpose of the protection of the interest of the Russian Federation in the procurement and realization of the wood of precious forest species and in the performance of the foreign trade operations therewith, the Government of the Russian Federation resolves:

- 1. To establish that the minimum rates of the payment for the standing wood of precious forest species, approved by the Decision of the Government of the Russian Federation No. 1199 of September 19, 1997 (Sobraniye zakonodatelstva Rossiyskoy Federatsii, 1997, No. 40, item 4587) shall be applicable as from January 15, 1999 with a raising coefficient according to Annex No. 1.
- 2. The Federal Forestry Service of Russia, jointly with the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Russian Federation, the State Customs Committee of the Russian Federation and the bodies of the state power of the Maritime, Khabarovsk and Krasnodar Territories and the Amur Region and of other interested entities of the Russian Federation shall strengthen the state control over the observance of the requirements of the legislation in the procurement, realization and export of the timber of precious forest species.
- 3. To introduce as from February 15, 1999 the licensing of the export from the Russian Federation of the timber of precious species by the list according to Annex No. 2.
- 4. The Ministry of Trade of the Russian Federation shall carry out the issuance of the licences for the export of the timber of precious forest species, mentioned in Annex No. 2 to this Decision, in the automatic regime (without quantitative restrictions).

The issuance of the licences for the export of the timber of precious forest species shall be carried out by the Ministry of Trade of the Russian Federation in the established procedure on the ground of the applications of the Russian exporters in accordance with the Regulations on the Procedure for the Licensing of the Export and Import of Goods (Works, Services) in the Russian Federation, approved by the Decision of the Government of the Russian Federation No. 1299 of October 31, 1996 (Sobraniye zakonodatelstva Rossiyskoy Federatsii, 1996, No. 46, item 5249).

5. The State Customs Committee of the Russian Federation shall:

carry out the customs clearance of the exportable timber mentioned in Annex No. 2 to this Decision only if the exporters have the licences issued by the Ministry of Trade of the Russian Federation;

submit quarterly to the Ministry of Trade of the Russian Federation the statistical information about the volumes of the export of the said timber.
