

DECREE
OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION
NO. 972 OF SEPTEMBER 2, 1997
ON MEASURES FOR THE FULFILMENT BY THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION
OF THE RESOLUTIONS OF THE UN SECURITY COUNCIL WITH RESPECT
TO THE CREATION OF AN INTERNATIONAL MECHANISM FOR THE CONSTANT
SUPERVISION AND CONTROL OVER DELIVERIES TO IRAQ
(with the Amendments and Additions of September 1, 2001)

For the purpose of the fulfilment by the Russian Federation of Resolution 1051 of the UN Security of March 27, 1996 with respect to the creation of an international mechanism for the constant observation and control over deliveries to Iraq of goods, technologies and facilities covered by the supervision and control approved by Resolution 715 of the UN Security Council of October 11, 1991, without infringing upon the lawful right of Iraq to import or export unprohibited goods, technologies and facilities intended for promoting its economic and social development, and in accordance with [Article 16](#) of the Federal Law on the State Regulation of Foreign Trade Activity, I hereby decree:

1. The approval of the List, submitted by the Government of the Russian Federation, of Dual-Purpose Goods and Technologies and Other Facilities, Whose Export to Iraq, in accordance with the UN Security Council Resolutions, Is Controlled and Is Subject to Notification, or Is Prohibited ([annexed](#)).

2. The pending the adoption by the UN Security Council of a decision amending or abolishing the restrictive measures introduced with respect to Iraq, the export from the Russian Federation to Iraq of goods, technologies and other facilities mentioned in the List approved by Item 1 of the present Decree, with the exception of the materials, equipment and technologies whose export to Iraq is prohibited in accordance with the List, may be carried out only with the permission of the Committee constituted by Resolution 661 of the UN Security Council of August 6, 1990.

3. The Government of the Russian Federation shall approve the Regulations on the Control over the Export to Iraq of Dual-Purpose Goods and Technologies and Other Facilities Falling under the International Mechanism for Constant Supervision and Control, ensuring it is put into effect simultaneously with the entry into force of the present Decree.

4. That the codes of the [Commodity Classification](#) of Foreign Economic Activity given in the List of Dual-Purpose Goods and Technologies and Other Facilities Whose Export to Iraq, in accordance with the UN Security Council Resolutions, Is Controlled, and Subject to Notification, or Is Prohibited, may, if necessary, be adjusted by the State Customs Committee of the Russian Federation in agreement with the Ministry of Economic Development and Trade of the Russian Federation.

5. The present Decree (except [Item 3](#)) shall enter into force on the expiry of three months from the day of its official publication.
