Amendments to the Regulation on a common procedure of veterinary control at the customs border of the Customs Union and the customs territory of the Customs Union approved by the Decision of the CU Commission on June 18, 2011

Introduce the following amendments into the Regulation on a common procedure of veterinary control at the customs border of the Customs Union and the customs territory of the Customs Union approved by the Decision of the CU Commission on June 18, 2011 No. 317:

1) point 3.8. reads as follows:

«3.8. Veterinary certificates for import of controlled goods at the customs territory of the Customs Union should be drawn in Russian and the language of exporter-country and/or in English»;

2) point 7.6. reads as follows:

«7.6. Owner of controlled goods, who received permit for transit of controlled goods through the customs territory of the Customs Union, has to comply with the veterinary requirements stipulated in points 7.1.-7.3. of this chapter.»;

3) second paragraph of point 11.3 add ", composite products; gelatine;" after "feeds of plant origin ".
