## ARMAN BAISSUANOV

DEPUTY PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE, PERMANENT MISSION OF KAZAKHSTAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS OFFICE AND OTHER INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS



Mr Arman Baissuanov has been working in Kazakhstan's mission in Geneva since 2018 and deals with issues related to disarmament, health, inter-parliamentary cooperation and the dialogue among religions.

He joined the Foreign Ministry in 1995 and has been previously posted in diplomatic missions in Geneva, London and Jeddah. He specializes in multilateral disarmament negotiations, contributed to the establishment of a nuclear-weapon-free zone in Central Asia and the implementation of a number of Kazakhstan's initiatives on regional security. Currently he is a chair of the meeting of experts on national implementation of the Convention on prohibition of biological weapons.

Mr Arman Baissuanov holds a master's degree in Conflict, Security and Development from King's College London.
