CO-EDITOR OF THE "EURASIAN PERSPECTIVE ON TRADE AND WTO" BOOK



Alexei Kireyev, from Russia, is a senior economist at the International Monetary Fund and the former IMF representative to the WTO (2000 to 2003). He has led advanced IMF missions to member countries, provided advice on macroeconomic policies to countries with IMF-supported programmes, and reviewed IMF policy advice, financing and technical assistance. Prior to joining the IMF, he was an economic advisor to President Gorbachev, an economist at the World Bank, and a professor of international economics at universities in Russia and the United States. His degrees include a MA in Economics from the George Washington University and a PhD in Economics from Moscow State Institute of International Relations (Russia). Dr Kireyev has researched and published extensively on international economics and trade, applied macroeconomics, principles of economics, and economic problems of low-income countries. His most recent publication includes a two-volume book on *International Microeconomics and International Macroeconomics* (2013).
