Is currently advising businesses and governments on wide range of trade policy issues as conselleur at Moscow based WTO Expertise Center. He is also engaged in academic and training activities being head of Trade Policy Department of the Russian Higher School of Economics (University).

Mr Medvedkov served as Head of the Department for Trade Negotiations (2004-2019) and Deputy Minister for Economic Development and Trade of the Russian Federation (2000 to 2004), as well as Director of the private trade policy consulting company - the Centre for Trade Policy and Law in Moscow (1996 to 2000). Before that he served at different positions in Ministry of foreign trade (since 1979) and Trade delegation in Switzerland (1982-1986).

From 2000, he was a Chief Negotiator for Russia's accession to the WTO and, following completion of these negotiations in 2012, the Chief Negotiator of Russia at the WTO. He was also chief trade negotiator for several dozens trade agreements and represented Russia in different multilateral foras.
